MVP: Midlife Vascular Risk Factors for Alzheimer's Disease in Persons with Cardiomyopathy Research Study

This two-year observational study looks to determine the relationship between cardiovascular disease, cognition, and Alzheimer's disease risk factors during middle age.

Participation involves:

- 3 study visits over 2 years
- Blood Draws
- Vascular Ultrasound
- Measurements of Cerebrospinal Fluid (Lumbar Puncture)
- Memory Tests
- Questionnaires

You may be eligible if you:

- Are between the ages of 45-65 years
- Have normal cognition or minor memory problems
- Have been diagnosed with heart failure or cardiomyopathy
- Willing to complete study procedures
- Complete eligibility phone screen and brief memory screening

Participants will be compensated a total of \$450 over the 2 years.
